From Chairside to Future DDS: Grace Wargo's Path to Dentistry

We believe every great clinician starts with a passion for people. For Grace Wargo, that passion led her from assisting chairside to actively pursuing her dream of becoming a dentist. While her path wasn't traditional—originally planning to become a physician assistant—it was shaped by firsthand patient care experiences and the encouragement of mentors within the Coastal team.

"I always knew I wanted to be in healthcare," Grace shares, "but something was missing." It wasn't until a conversation with her friend's father who is a local Periodontist, on a boat, no less, that dentistry came into focus. Grace, who once felt vulnerable in the dental chair herself, now uses that personal experience to foster empathy with patients. "You can't teach that kind of empathy in a classroom," she says. Currently enrolled in a Post Baccalaureate program at the University of New England, Grace is laying the academic foundation to apply to dental school, with hopes of returning to Coastal one day, this time as Dr. Wargo.

Working at Coastal has given Grace more than just technical knowledge. It's instilled a deep understanding of the human side of dentistry. Whether it's connecting with a patient living with dementia or learning to anticipate a doctor's next move during a complex case, Grace has embraced every opportunity to grow. Beyond the operatory, Grace has demonstrated a deep commitment to care that transcends borders. During college, she participated in a medical mission trip to Costa Rica—an experience that broadened her perspective on global health and the power of human connection in healing. Chicken Caesar Waffle Recipe

IngredientsFor 1 serving

Sandwich

- 1 cup cooked chicken, shredded or chopped
- ½ teaspoon paprika
- ½ teaspoon salt-free garlic seasoning
- 1 egg
- ½ cup romaine lettuce, roughly chopped
- 4 tablespoons grated parmesan cheese
- I slice turkey bacon, chopped
- ¼ avocado, sliced
- ¼ tomato, sliced



Caesar Dressing

- 1 teaspoon anchovy paste
- I small garlic clove, minced
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice, freshly squeezed
- 1 teaspoon dijon mustard
- 1 teaspoon worcestershire sauce
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- ½ cup freshly grated parmigianoreggiano cheese
- ½ teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 1 tablespoon water
- salt, to taste

Preparation

- For the dressing: Combine the mayonnaise, garlic, lemon juice, Dijon mustard, Worcestershire sauce, and salt in a bowl. Stir to combine.
- Stir in the Parmesan cheese, followed by the water. Season generously with black pepper to taste.
- 3. For the sandwich: In a bowl, combine the chicken, egg, paprika, garlic seasoning, and 3 tbsp of Parmesan cheese.
- Place the chicken mixture into a preheated waffle maker and cook for approximately 3 minutes or until crispy.
- 5. While the waffles are cooking, mix the lettuce with 1 tbsp of the Caesar dressing. Cook the turkey bacon in a pan until crispy.
- Assemble the waffle sandwich by layering the lettuce, avocado, tomato, turkey bacon, remaining Parmesan, and a drizzle of Caesar dressing between two chicken waffles.


BOOK NOOK
